WHAT IS COREACT

WHO WE ARE

mafianeindanke e.V. is a non-profit association engaged in the prevention of mafia phenomena, organised crime and corruption based in Germany. Formally registered in 2009, it was initiated by a group of Italian restaurantowners in Berlin, who opposed and denounced a request of protection money in 2007, just a couple of months after a multiple mafia-murder had taken place in Duisburg. Since then, the main goal of the association is to raise awareness about the presence of mafias and organised crime in the country, and inform about the risks that those phenomena represent for democracy, social justice, equality and freedom.

mafianeindanke is part of the European network CHANCE – Civil Hub Against orgaNised Crime in Europe. Many CHANCE members will participate to the event sharing their own experiences.
